# Saskatchewan Blue Cross Gardenscape Art Show and Sale - March 28-30, 2025



# Application Deadline: February 21, 2025

You are invited to participate in the Annual Saskatchewan Blue Cross Gardenscape Art Show and Sale to be held during Saskatchewan Blue Cross Gardenscape, March 28-30, 2025, at Prairieland Park in Saskatoon. On average, Saskatchewan Blue Cross Gardenscape attracts more than 15,000 people annually from across the province and western Canada. Participation in this show will provide artists with an opportunity to display and sell their works to a diverse audience.

## Guidelines

- Artists can apply for exhibit space (one side of display board) to show and sell their works. Each display board is 4' high x 8' long (grey) with a maximum of two artists permitted to display on each board (1-sided). The exhibit fee is \$75.00 plus GST for each board (or side) which includes one (1) admission button valid for general admission for the duration of the event. Additional buttons can be purchased at the venue show office.
- Artists are not limited to the number of pieces that they hang and will be required to hang their own work.
  Prairieland Park will supply the materials required for hanging the artwork. Prairieland Park will provide an 8 ½" X 11" sheet with the artists name on it, to be displayed on the board in the bottom left corner. A business card holder is also supplied on each art board to enable artists to display business cards if desired.
- Volunteers will be scheduled throughout the show hours to monitor the exhibit, and artists are encouraged to volunteer in this area.
- It is the artist's responsibility to label each piece (not handwritten) including a price, if for sale. All artwork sales will be handled by the artist (purchaser will contact artist directly) no commission will be taken. The boards must remain full throughout the show and if pieces have been sold, arrangements must be made to get the art to the purchaser after the show. If the purchaser is from out of town, you may sell the art piece and replace the art work with a new item immediately. This system must be honoured and will be monitored by our head art show volunteer during the show. Prairieland Park will supply coloured dots that will be placed on pieces of art that have been sold.
- The artist may also provide extra lighting on their board if they deem necessary.

### **Submission Guidelines:**

All original two-dimensional fine art and photography are acceptable. Artwork **must** have a floral, garden or landscape theme. (For other types of garden art or 3-dimensional art that may fit the theme, please contact our office for rates.) *We do not accept the display, sale, or promotion of artwork that has been generated or altered using any form of Artificial Intelligence.* 

Confirmation will not be complete until fees are paid upon notification of acceptance.
